

## RULES OF PLAY

Out of bounds is defined by white stakes that border the outer perimeter of the golf course. Red stakes define lateral hazards and yellow stakes define water hazards.

Local Rule: All native grass areas should be played in the same manner as lateral hazards. Should you choose to play from those areas; you may, however, ground your club.

The golf committee suggests that the following parameters govern the selection of tees:

Medal Tees (Gold): Professionals or players with a USGA handicap of 10 or less.

Ross Tees (Bronze): Players with a USGA handicap of 20 or less.

Regular Tees (Black): Players with a USGA handicap of 30 or less.

Forward Tees (Silver): Players of all skill levels are welcome to enjoy the forward tees.

Please maintain a reasonable pace of play. A round of golf that lasts more than four and one half hours does not follow Donald Ross' philosophy that "Golf should be a pleasure, not a penance".
