## Volunteer Committees and Descriptions

<u>Committee</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Committee</u>	<u>Description</u>
<b>Card Copy</b>	This committee copies the players' scorecards after 18 holes to assist in the scoring system.	<b>Shuttle</b>	This committee will shuttle players from specific greens to their next tee. Also, in the event of course evacuation, these shuttles will be used to bring players in from the golf course.
<b>Contestant Evacuation</b>	Vans and shuttle carts will be stationed in different areas on the golf courses in the event that players need to be evacuated. These volunteers will hold keys to the vehicles, and remain in the area where the vehicles are staged during their shift.	<b>Standard Bearers*</b>	Members of this committee will carry the scoring standards (small scoreboards), for each group of contestants.
<b>Leader Boards</b>	This committee will be responsible for posting the players' scorers on the leader boards located throughout both golf courses.	<b>Tee Refreshments**</b>	This committee will stock coolers with product, ice the coolers down and deliver them to the starting tees and other locations TBD during practice rounds and Championship Rounds.
<b>Marshals</b>	Marshals will be assigned to various holes and areas of the course. They will assist with maintaining gallery control and ease the flow of movement for players and caddies.	<b>Volunteer Services Tent</b>	Maintain the volunteer tent with duties such as give directions and help volunteers find their committees, as well as check-out/check-in committee radios.
<b>Public Score/ Summary Board</b>	This committee will be in charge of posting scores on the public scoreboard and summary board, and after the cut, for posting individual hole-by-hole scores for every player.	<b>Walking Scorers</b>	One Walking Scorer will be assigned to walk with each group of players and be required to keep the players' scorers, as well as selected statistics. Walking Scores <b>MUST HAVE A HANDICAP OF 15 OR LOWER.</b>
<b>Scoring Control</b>	This committee is responsible for receiving the players' scores transmitted by the walking scorers, checking the scoreboard copies, and distributing those scores to the event scoreboards and television compound.	<b>Golf Channel</b>	This committee will help assist the Golf Channel staff and their needs.
<b>Golf Maintenance</b>	This committee is designed to assist the golf maintenance staff with tournament preparations.		

\*Junior volunteers (under the age of 18) will be considered for this committee only. \*\*May be required to lift up to 30 lbs.
