2. While you are heading toward the Lobby, what year is included in the name of our steakhouse?

3. What room number can be found on the West Baden Springs Hotel key?

Bonus: What year was that key used?

4. Who did the large desk located in the corner of the Lobby near the fireplace belong to?

Bonus: In what country was he born?

5. What two types of wood were used to make the Bowles Tall Case Clock in the Lobby?

Stay in the Lobby and look up at the large murals on the ceiling.

6. This is the mythological story of Pluto, the mascot of the mineral water here at the French Lick Springs Hotel. There is a dog in one of the murals. How many heads does it have?

Bonus: Can you name the dog? (You may need to Google it to find the correct answer.)

Head down the hallway toward the Spa to find the framed picture of an envelope displayed near the Spa entrance.

7. How much did a bottle of Pluto Water cost in 1915?

Take the elevator near the Spa entrance to the lower level (LL). Exit to the left toward Pluto's Alley.

8. Bowling has been an important part of our history for more than 125 years. How many lanes are in Pluto's Alley?

Back track and head into the Tunnel.

9. In what year was the Tunnel created?

Continue all the way through the Tunnel.

10. After exiting, find the picture showing what stood on this site before the hotel was built. What was this structure?

Go outside through the valet entrance and find Walking Tour plaque #21 on the left.

 In what year did Chef Louis Perrin first serve tomato juice as a beverage here?

Head back inside to the lower level through the valet entrance. Turn right and then left. Proceed down the hallway and make your way to the Garden Exit. Once outside, find the Pluto Spring House.

Go back inside and proceed toward the Grand Colonnade Restaurant by making two left turns.

13. This room was once known as the Convention Hall. At the Governor's Conference of 1931, New York Governor Franklin D. Roosevelt gained support from his party in this room to begin his run for President of the United States. How many round columns are there in this room? Don't forget to count those behind the buffet.

Take the elevator as you enter the Grand Colonnade to the Lobby level (L), turn left and proceed through the Promenade of Shops to the Event Center.

14. As you enter the Event Center, next to the concierge desk, you will find a fiddle in a shadow box hanging on the wall. Who did it belong to?

Proceed toward the escalators and locate the display case just past them that contains Pluto Water memorabilia.

15. What color is the oldest Pluto bottle in our collection?

Head toward the parking garage and turn down the hallway on the left of the Event Center. Look at the wall of historic photos near the Johnson Room.
