



LEGENDARY GOLF

Few things in the world of golf get the blood pumping like the mention of Pete Dye, Donald Ross and Tom Bendelow in the same sentence. Nowhere else in the world can a golfer play courses created by each of these prolific designers at one location. The rolling hills of southern Indiana provide a beautiful yet challenging place for a casual meeting on the course.

THE PETE DYE COURSE

In 2009, legendary course designer and Hall of Fame architect Pete Dye carved a course into the hillside of the second-highest point in Indiana. The Pete Dye Course at French Lick quickly became one of the most highly acclaimed courses in the country. The course features 18 holes of narrow fairways, rugged terrain and 40-mile panoramic views of the countryside.

THE DONALD ROSS COURSE

This classic course, designed by iconic architect Donald Ross in 1917, underwent a \$5 million restoration in collaboration with the Donald Ross Society. The course features Ross' trademark flatbottom bunkers with deep, gnarly faces and severely undulating rectangular-shaped greens. The legendary course has been home to many regional and national tournaments, including the 1924 PGA Championship won by the legendary Walter Hagen.

THE VALLEY LINKS COURSE

The Valley Links Course is a fully walkable, par-36 park-like course with rolling fairways, Scottish-style fescue grasses and strategically placed bunkers. This course is home to the French Lick Golf Academy that provides a variety of instruction including full swing, short game, video analysis and custom club fitting.

FRENCH LICK RESORT HISTORY




TROLLEY

Trolley service first came to the resort in 1903 with the addition of an electric trolley. Guests could catch the streetcar at the steps of West Baden Springs Hotel and go all the way (a whole mile) into downtown French Lick. It was a raging success, and in 1916 the trolley set a record for carrying 250,000 people in a single year. At a nickel a ride, that's over \$300,000 in revenue. Not bad for what was billed as the "world's shortest trolley line." Be sure to check out our restored trolley running between the two hotels. Save your nickels; this one is on us.

1931 NATIONAL GOVERNORS' CONFERENCE

The most notable of political events in resort history came in 1931 when it hosted to the annual National Governors' Conference. It was here, in the lower level of French Lick Springs Hotel, that Franklin D. Roosevelt rounded up support for his party's presidential nomination. By the time the two-day event concluded, it was considered to be one of the most important meetings of the state governors since the annual conferences began in 1908.






FRENCH LICK SPRINGS HOTEL

In 1845, Dr. William Bowles, a nearby physician, opened the first French Lick Springs Hotel. Bowles explored the healing properties of the mineral springs in the area. In 1901 the outgoing mayor of Indianapolis, Tom Taggart, along with a small group of investors, bought the property. It was under Taggart's imaginative direction that French Lick Springs Hotel rose to international prominence. He expanded using the yellow "French Lick" brick, luxurious furnishings and marble floors, two golf courses and started bottling Pluto Water for national sale. He also encouraged the Monon Railroad to lay a special spur and run daily trains between Chicago and the hotel.

HAGENBECK-WALLACE CIRCUS

Did you know that one of the early industries in the area was entertainment? Ed Ballard, a local businessman who controlled gambling interests in town, was a partner in the American Circus Corporation. ACC, second in size only to Ringling Brothers, purchased the Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus after a devastating flood in Peru, Indiana. Hagenbeck-Wallace lost 8 elephants, 21 lions and tigers and 8 performing horses in the catastrophe. In 1915, housing was constructed and the circus wintered in French Lick. You can learn more about the circus and see a 1,100 square foot diorama at the French Lick West Baden Museum.



From presidential nominations to professional athletes and miracle healing waters, there's no denying that our history is a storied one. So what's our claim to fame? We couldn't possibly pick just one, so here are a few of the highlights that put us on the map.



PLUTO WATER

The numerous natural mineral springs throughout the area were the first real draw to French Lick and West Baden. The spring water, named "Pluto Water" after the Roman god of the underworld, was highly sought after for its purported medicinal qualities. Advertised as a cure-all miracle, sales of Pluto Water in drugstores across the country had surpassed the \$1 million mark in 1919 with 450 carloads shipping annually. Production ceased in 1971 after strong traces of lithium were discovered in the water.





EIGHTH WONDER OF THE WORLD

Following the great West Baden Springs Hotel fire in 1901, Lee W. Sinclair declared that he would build a brand-new hotel within a year and, it would be completely fireproof. Unknown West Virginia architect Harrison Albright took on the challenge of designing the building that would house the world's largest dome and Oliver J. Wescott, a bridge engineer, designed the dome trusses. To complete the structure before the first anniversary of the fire, a 500-man crew worked six days a week in 10-hour shifts for 270 days, at a total cost of \$414,000.

TOMATO JUICE

In 1917, world-famous chef Louis Perrin first served tomato juice at French Lick Springs Hotel. As luck would have it one morning he was out of oranges and could not serve the traditional orange juice. Needing to serve some sort of juice at breakfast, Chef Perrin squeezed tomatoes and the rest is history.



THE ORIGINAL TOMATO JUICE In 1926 chemists of recognized standing, working in the laboratories of an eminent University, carried out the first scientific investigation of the value of canned tomato juice. FRENCH LICK Tomato Juice was used in these experiments as it was then the only juice available. Results were published in a leading scientific journal. FRENCH LICK Tomato Juice is expressed from carefully selected tomatoes ripened on the vine in the hills of Southern Indiana. It is slightly















AREA ATTRACTIONS




SCHOOL HOUSE - GROUND LEVEL - EB RHODES ROOM


