	Glass / Bottle
Livio Felluga (Friuli Colli Orientali, Italy) Rich and multi-layered: orange blossom, daisy and white wisteria develop in ripe fruit notes of apricot, Percoca peach, white melon and yellow peach.	59
Chloe (Valdadige, Italy) Flavors of juicy white peach, soft melon, crisp apple and floral honeysuckle with a subtle undertone of Meyer lemon.	11 40
Danzante (Delle Venezie, Italy) A bouquet of fruity and citrus notes of citron are accompanied by fine floral accents.	12 39

CHARDONNAY

LVE John Legend (Napa Valley, California) Rich texture on the palate with vanilla crème and toasty oak balanced with a touch of baking spices.	98
Jordan (Russian River Valley, California) Aromas of fresh green apples lead to an elegant palate of apple and subtle creaminess, live acidity and a hint of toasted oak.	96
William Fevre Chablis Champs Royaux (Burgundy, France) Notes of citrus and white fleshed fruit with a very slight oak finish. Fresh and supple, marked by mineral notes.	20 76
Sonoma-Cutrer (Sonoma County, California) Intense, showing spicy citrus flavors that are tight and full-bodied, ending with a flinty, mineral aftertaste.	16 60

Duckhorn (Napa Valley, California) Tastes of mild green apple with a hint of pink grapefruit and mild minerality. A dry and pleasantly refreshing finish.	16 62
Whitehaven (Marlborough, New Zealand) Displays lift of grapefruit and white currants, with hints of freshly crushed herbs.	12 45
Marlborough Estate Reserve (Marlborough, New Zealand) Luscious and gently textured with flavors of ripe guava, citrus and black currant, kissed with an elegant mineral note.	32

Snoqualmie (Columbia Valley, Washington) Sweet but balanced with racy acidity, offering apricot, peach, nutmeg and cream aromas and flavors that linger expressively.	11 40

Zagara Moscato d'Asti; Marchesi di Barolo (Piedmont, Italy) Aromatic and intense with scents of orange blossoms, peach and apricot flowers.	14 52
Moscato d'Asti; Castello del Poggio (Piedmont, Italy) Light and frothy with sweet apple and light meringue notes. Medium sweet.	13 50
Vouvray; Sauvion (Loire Valley, France) Medium bodied with food-friendly acidity. Flavors of honey, ripe pear and dried fruit lead to a long finish.	12 48
La Solitude Blanc (Côtes du Rhone, France) Citrus and apricot on the nose, along with white flowers. Round and greedy on the mouth with a fresh, tasty finish.	11 37

ROSÉ

Hecht & Bannier (Bandol; Provence, France) This rosé blend of Chardonnay, Grenache and Pinot Noir smells like wild red fruit and the sea; like eating strawberries on the beach. Bright acidity with a nice tart fruit core, keeping the wine soft.	11 41
Campuket (Rhône Valley, France) Delicate in both aroma and flavor. Particularly fruity taste of raspberries and strawberries with a refreshing acidity.	39

PINOT NOIR

Beaux Freres Vineyard (Willamette Valley, Oregon) Sleek and silky with cherry and mineral flavors that glide seamlessly through a long, vivid finish.	122
Benton-Lane (Willamette Valley, Oregon) Vibrant notes of bright red fruits like cherries and cranberries mingle with subtle notes of baking spice.	61
Meiomi (Central Coast, California) Deep, rich garnet color with aromas of ripe berries, fresh cranberry, candy apple and malted vanilla.	13 58
Buena Vista (North Coast, California) Ripe red fruit aromas mixed with cardamom and cocoa powder continue through to the palate with cherry pie accented by notes of cinnamon and mocha.	43
Böen (Coastal California) Bursting with bright fruit flavors of cherry, strawberry, and blackberry. Very well balanced with hints of cocoa and caramel on the long-lasting finish.	11 39

Layer Cake (Mendoza, Argentina) Big, brooding, black fruit then rich earth, truffles and dark cocoa. Elegant with fresh-picked blackberries and chocolate; so many layers.	50
Susana Balbo Signature (Uco Valley, Argentina) A floral, pure expression of South American wine country. Exploding aromas of dark fruit with well-integrated oak and filigree tannins.	14 50
Trivento (Mendoza, Argentina) Straightforward, with polished cherry pie and raspberry flavors backed by a dash of sweet toast.	11 42

MERLOT

Handprint; Meeker (Sonoma County, California) Cherries and hints of strawberry rhubarb pie tantalize on the palate with toasty oak and powerful tannins throughout the finish.	88
St. Francis (Sonoma County, California) Rich and full-bodied with superb fruit depth and voluptuous, ripe berry flavors carrying into a long, lovely finish.	10 39
Diamond Collection; Francis Ford Coppola Winery (Sonoma County, California) Intense aromatics of raspberry and blueberry introduce flavors of crushed berries, vanilla and leather, which are wrapped up in soft, smooth tannins.	10 38
Bonterra Organic Vineyards (Mendocino and Lake Counties, California) Aromas of blueberry and plum, layered over a subtle thread of graphite, pencil shaving and a suggestion of dried herbs.	37



SHIRAZ

Grange Bin 95; Penfolds (Barossa Valley, Australia)	1054
Smooth and seductive, delivering a chorus of currant, plum, blackberry and spice flavors, hinting at coffee and cardamom as the finish floats easily over a bed of refined tannins.	
Kalimna Bin 28; Penfolds (Barossa Valley, Australia)	16 58
Offers savory and mineral overtones to its dark berry flavors. The finish lets the flavors sail against a mild grip of tannins.	
The Plan; McGuigan (Southeastern Australia)	10 32
Well-rounded and fruity with rich flavors of ripe plum, blackberry jam and spices balanced with vanilla and caramel flavors.	

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Silver Oak (Napa Valley, California)	201
Tight, tannic and full-bodied with cedar, dried currant, sage and herbal notes.	
Cade Howell Mountain (Napa Valley, California)	198
A seductive style, rich and layered with a tempting overlay of intense, creamy mocha-laced red and dark berry flavors that are deep and persistent.	
Mercury Head (Napa Valley, California)	182
Sturdy structure with blueberry and crème de cassis fruit, Christmas fruitcake, cedar and white chocolate notes.	
Burgess Contadina (Napa Valley, California)	180
Dense aromas and flavors of blackberry and stewed cassis. The lush fruit is brought into balance by high tone herbal aromatics of mint, sage and sweet tobacco. A long, velvety finish.	
Austin Hope (Paso Robles, California)	122
Beautiful ruby hue with aromas of fresh black cherry, burnt sugar and a slight smokiness. On the palate, flavors of vanilla, ripe dark fruit, roasted coffee and nuances of spice.	
Artemis; Stag's Leap (Napa Valley, California)	148
Inviting aromas of black cherry and plum with hints of vanilla.	
Raymond Reserve Velvet (Napa Valley, California)	22 88
A sweet kiss of crème de cassis, licorice, camphor and subtle toast, with silky tannin and impressive purity and length.	
Sequoia Grove (Napa Valley, California)	90
Flavors of sweet, ripe raspberries come through and accent smooth tannins and creamy weight with an impeccable balance and a long finish.	
Quilt (Napa Valley, California)	16 56
Rich and satisfying with flavors of boysenberry jam, black cherry pie filling and cocoa, layered with notes of vanilla and hazelnut.

<p>Cum Laude; Castello Banfi (Montalcino, Italy) Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese and Syrah marry with sweet berry, currant and flower scents. Full-bodied, balanced and refined with polished, silky tannins and a long finish.</p>	77
<p>Vietti Perbacco; Langhe Nebbiolo (Piedmont, Italy) Quite intense and generous fruity nose with red berries along with floral and spicy notes, a hint of menthol and hard candy.</p>	16 58
<p>Lacryma Christi del Vesuvio; Mastroberardino (Campania, Italy) Aromas of cherries, plums, raspberries, and black pepper. Refined, light tannins and bright acidity make for a lifting, fruity finish.</p>	51
<p>Centine Rosso; Castello Banfi (Montalcino, Italy) Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot join in a smooth and fragrantly satisfying blend. Well-rounded with flavors of black cherry, tart plum and hints of spice.</p>	11 44

<p>Châteauneuf-du-Pape; Domaine de la Solitude (Rhône, France) Bouquet of garrigue and red fruits. Roundness on the palate, balanced with a nice sweetness, with aromas of cocoa and morello cherry, leading into a long, suave finish.</p>	92
<p>Château Puy-Blanquet (Saint-Émilion, France) Notes of warm, dark, ripe berries and fruitcake with hints of baking spices and herbs. Full-bodied with firm, chewy tannins and bold freshness, finishing long and flavorful.</p>	19 70
<p>Bourgogne; Joseph Drouhin (Burgundy, France) Red fruit aromas of raspberry, red currants and wild strawberry. Pleasant, fruity and refreshing on the palate with light tannins and great elegance.</p>	13 48
<p>Vinsobres Les Cornuds; Famille Perrin (Rhône, France) Rich and complex with notes of brandy cherries, blackberries, black fruit jam and chocolate. Full and powerful on the palate with gourmet aromas, round tannins and perfectly balanced acidity.</p>	11 39

ZINFANDEL

Old Ghost; Klinker Brick (Lodi, California) Deep blackberry and plum aromas mingle with the vanilla and toast of the barrels to deliver soft, supple tannins and strong complexity.	90
Bear Flag (Sonoma County, California) Spicy in character, complemented by jammy, dark fruit flavors reminiscent of blueberry pie. Notes of toasted oak and vanilla complete the structure and full body.	20 80
Dry Creek (Sonoma County, California) Complex with bright acidity, complimented by deeper notes of dark berries, mocha, white pepper and wild sage brush.	12 50

UNIQUE REDS

Opus One (Napa Valley, California) Aromas of blackberry, cassis and black cherry, white pepper and rose petals. Flavors of fresh and juicy black fruit, accented with hints of orange zest, licorice and dark chocolate. Round tannins and acidity combine to create a soft, creamy mouthfeel and extend the flavors into a long, persistent finish.	473
8 Years in the Desert (Napa Valley, California) Predominate zinfandel, blended with sirah. Complex flavors of ripe, brambly fruit, earthy notes and hints of espresso.	135
Paraduxx; Duckhorn Vineyards (Napa Valley, California) Dark and brambly with raspberry, black cherry, cedar and dark chocolate notes plus hints of pepper, cinnamon, clove and molasses.	105
Hands of Time; Stag's Leap (Napa Valley, California) Vibrant aromas and juicy flavors of red cherry, raspberry and strawberry mingle with warm vanilla and a lingering spice character.	17 64
Pessimist (Paso Robles, California) Aromas of blueberry, boysenberry, black plum, truffle, cocoa and cardamon spice. On the palate, black cherry, blueberry, crème de cassis and hints of lavender, anise and black olive complement the rich, ripe fruit flavors.	12 41
Caymus-Suisun Grand Durif (Suisun Valley, California) Notes of blackberries, rose petals and hint of clove. Flavors of berry cobbler mingle with leather, a wisp of campfire, blooming flowers and chocolate covered raisins. Dark chocolate and bright fruit come through on the finish.	15 55
