PINOT GRIGIO

	Glass / Bottle
Livio Felluga (Friuli Colli Orientali, Italy) Rich and multi-layered: orange blossom, daisy and white wisteria develop in ripe fruit notes of apricot, Percoca peach, white melon and yellow peach.	18 59
Chloe (Valdadige, Italy) Flavors of juicy white peach, soft melon, crisp apple and floral honeysuckle with a subtle undertone of Meyer lemon.	11 40

CHARDONNAY

	Glass / Bottle
Cake Bread (Napa Valley, California) Light, golden color with aromas of green apple, lemon and pear accented by hints of white flowers and baking spice. Palate is medium-bodied with flavors of ripe melon, lemon curd, crème brûlée and vanilla. Fresh acidity and just-picked citrus flavors are balanced with subtle oak notes.	92
Rombauer Carneros (Napa-Sonoma, California) Aromas of ripe yellow peach, melon and chamomile, all framed by freshly baked pie crust. The palate is bright with flavors of nectarine followed by a subtle spice and lively acidity. Rich flavors and a creamy texture. <i>Also available in 375ml bottle - \$25</i>	22 83
Benton-Lane (Willamette Valley, Oregon) Elegant and nuanced with aromas of jasmine, honeydew melon, Key lime and lemon thyme. Flavors of Meyer lemon, white peach, quince and freshly baked tart are highlighted on the palate.	20 74
Sonoma-Cutrer (Sonoma County, California) Intense, showing spicy citrus flavors that are tight and full-bodied, ending with a flinty, mineral aftertaste.	16 60
Singing Tree (Russian River Valley, California) Light straw in color with aromas of yellow peaches and subtropical fruits. Flavors of nectarine, baked pear and limoncello. Round, silky and luxurious with enough minerality for a clean finish.	48

Duckhorn (Napa Valley, California) Tastes of mild green apple with a hint of pink grapefruit and mild minerality. A dry and pleasantly refreshing finish.	16 62

RIESLING

Glass / Bottle

Trimbach (Alsace, France)

In the dry and balanced Trimbach style. Aromas of lemon, pear, tropical fruit with candied orange; elegant liveliness, crunchiness and notes of white flowers and citrus fruits lead to a minerally finish.

Valckenberg (Rheinhessen, Germany)

12 43

Fine peach aroma and sweet, full-bodied, harmonious structure. The Valckenberg varietals represent authentic and typical German wines.

Spätlese; Schmitt Söhne (Piesport, Germany)

11 39

Full-bodied, lush and rich with flavors of ripe apricots, apples and peaches. Well-balanced and firm, giving an intense and lingering finish.

FRENCH WHITE

Glass / Bottle

Albert Bichot Chablis (Domaine Long-Depaquit; Bourgogne, France)

17 64

Elegant complexity on the nose with intense aromas of candied lemon and subtle hints of white flowers. A neat, chiseled and lively structure with a mineral finish featuring saline and iodine nuances.

Sauvion Vouvray (Loire Valley, France)

12 48

Medium bodied with food-friendly acidity. Flavors of honey, ripe pear and dried fruit lead to a long finish.

La Solitude Blanc (Côtes du Rhone, France)

11 37

Citrus and apricot on the nose along with white flowers. Round and greedy on the mouth with a fresh, tasty finish.

M. Chapoutier Belleruche Blanc (Rhône Valley, France)

10 36

An expressive wine with aromas of apricot, fennel and floral scents. The wine's roundness is a perfect match for its freshness, with a finish revealing subtle notes of aniseed.

ROSÉ

Glass / Bottle

Château Sainte Marguerite Fantastique (Côtes de Provence, France)

20 74

Organic and vegan rosé made with precision from Grenache, Cinsault and Rolle grapes from the plots of the Château Sainte Marguerite vineyard. Aromas of vine peach, raspberry and plum. Nuances of guava and papaya. On the palate, citrus notes and floral ones of rose and jasmine.

Hecht & Bannier (Bandol; Provence, France)

41

This rosé blend of Chardonnay, Grenache and Pinot Noir smells like wild red fruit and the sea; like eating strawberries on the beach. Bright acidity with a nice tart fruit core, keeping the wine soft.

RED WINES

PINOT NOIR

	Glass / Bottle
Benton-Lane (Willamette Valley, Oregon) Vibrant notes of bright red fruits like cherries and cranberries mingle with subtle notes of baking spice.	61
San Simeon Monterey (Pasa Robles, California) Aromas of black cherry, raspberry, rhubarb, dark chocolate, black pepper and a hint of star anise. Characteristics of spicy cinnamon and deep black cherry fill the mouth on the finish.	14 52
Böen (Coastal California) Bursting with bright fruit flavors of cherry, strawberry, and blackberry. Very well balanced with hints of cocoa and caramel on the long-lasting finish.	11 39

MALBEC

	Glass / Bottle
Red Schooner Voyage 10; Caymus (Napa Valley, California) Made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains of Argentina and shipped chilled to Napa Valley, then produced in Caymus style: dense, dark, powerful and supple. Strikingly smooth, with scents and flavors of dark fruit and fine, textural tannins.	15 55
Layer Cake (Mendoza, Argentina) Big, brooding, black fruit then rich earth, truffles and dark cocoa. Elegant with fresh-picked blackberries and chocolate; so many layers.	50
Trivento Golden Reserve (Mendoza, Argentina) Very attractive aroma full of violets, lavender, blackberries and cola. Plum, blackberry, black cherry, licorice, a little spice and herbs, and a tinge of toasty oak are all on display in this medium to full-bodied wine.	13 48
Trapiche Medalla (Mendoza, Argentina) Concentrated aromas of red berries, plums, cherries and raisins, highlighted by notes of toast, coconut and vanilla from aging in new French oak barrels. A pleasant and persistent finish.	12 44

MERLOT

Decoy Limited; Duckhorn (Alexander Valley, California) Fragrances of ripe raspberry, Bing cherry and red currant, as well as notions of cedar and sweet baking spice from oak aging. On the palate, velvety tannins, red berry and spice flow to a long, juicy finish.	15 54
Six Stack; Markham Vineyards (Napa Valley, California) Aromas of ripe raspberry and plum jam, enhanced by caramel notes from oak aging. Red fruit flavors, notes of rich, velvety chocolate-covered cherries. A "cab lover's" merlot with structure, mid-palate weight and a long, round finish.	13 46
Diamond Collection; Francis Ford Coppola Winery (Sonoma County, California) Intense aromatics of raspberry and blueberry introduce flavors of crushed berries, vanilla and leather, which are wrapped up in soft, smooth tannins.	10 38
Bonterra Organic Vineyards (Mendocino and Lake Counties, California) Aromas of blueberry and plum, layered over a subtle thread of graphite, pencil shaving and a suggestion of dried herbs.	37



SHIRAZ

Glass / Bottle

Torbreck (Barossa Valley, Australia)

On the nose, wild berries, black plums, dark cherries, dried rich spices and a note of cured smoke. The palate reveals berry fruits with black plums, cassis, dark cherries, licorice, dried spices and mocha.

Max's Shiraz Cabernet; Penfolds (South Australia)

14 51

Exotic aromatic spices complement bright fruit notes of red berries and ripe plums. Notes of fresh cream and wild strawberries with a hint of cocoa powder. Fresh plums, ripe cherries and hints of pomegranate on the palate.

342

From the best barrels Caymus sets aside each year of its award-winning cabernet sauvignon. Distinguished by extremely fine, velvety tannins, a wine of structure with intense concentration of supple flavors and dark fruits. Touch of vanilla, chocolate, oak, plum and crème de cassis.

Silver Oak (Napa Valley, California)

Tight, tannic and full-bodied with cedar, dried currant, sage and herbal notes.

Cade Howell Mountain (Napa Valley, California)

A seductive style, rich and layered with a tempting overlay of intense, creamy mocha-laced red and dark berry flavors that are deep and persistent.

Mercury Head (Napa Valley, California)

Sturdy structure with blueberry and crème de cassis fruit, Christmas fruitcake, cedar and white chocolate notes.

Inviting aromas of black cherry and plum with hints of vanilla.

Caymus (Napa Valley, California)

Dark in color with rich fruit and ripe tannins – as approachable in youth as in maturity. Layered, lush aromas and flavors including cocoa, crème de cassis and ripe berries. Touch of earthiness, smoke, leather, blackberries, plum and vanilla.

Austin Hope (Paso Robles, California)

Beautiful ruby hue with aromas of fresh black cherry, burnt sugar and a slight smokiness. On the palate, flavors of vanilla, ripe dark fruit, roasted coffee and nuances of spice.

Raymond Reserve Velvet (Napa Valley, California)

26 100

A sweet kiss of crème de cassis, licorice, camphor and subtle toast, with silky tannin and impressive purity and length.

Sequoia Grove (Napa Valley, California)

26 97

Flavors of sweet, ripe raspberries come through and accent smooth tannins and creamy weight with an impeccable balance and a long finish.

Quilt (Napa Valley, California)

16 56

Rich and satisfying with flavors of boysenberry jam, black cherry pie filling and cocoa, layered with notes of vanilla and hazelnut.

Beni di Batasiolo Barolo (Piedmont, Italy)	22	83
A bouquet typical of the Nebbiolo grape: flowery and toasty with hints of sweet spice, nuts and delicate herbs. A balanced, elegant wine that is bold and intense.		
Cum Laude; Castello Banfi (Montalcino, Italy)		77
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese and Syrah marry with sweet berry, currant and flower scents. Full-bodied, balanced and refined with polished, silky tannins and a long finish.		
Vietti Perbacco; Langhe Nebbiolo (Piedmont, Italy)	16	58
Quite intense and generous fruity nose with red berries along with floral and spicy notes. Finishes with a hint of menthol and hard candy.		
Centine Rosso; Castello Banfi (Montalcino, Italy)	11	44
Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot join in a smooth and fragrantly satisfying blend. Well-rounded with flavors of black cherry, tart plum and hints of spice.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape; Domaine de la Solitude (Rhône Valley, France)		92
Bouquet of garrigue and red fruits. Roundness on the palate balanced with a nice sweetness, with aromas of cocoa and Morello cherry leading into a long, suave finish.		
Château Peymouton (Saint-Émilion-Grand Cru, France)	18	66
Dense and full-bodied with dark ripe berries, plum, blackberry and blueberry mixed with oak, tobacco and vanilla notes. Finishes with a touch of earthiness and smoky notes.		
Bourgogne; Joseph Drouhin (Burgundy, France)	13	48
Red fruit aromas of raspberry, red currants and wild strawberry. Pleasant, fruity and refreshing on the palate with light tannins and great elegance.		
Nicolas Potel (Beaujolais, France)	12	42
Light-bodied with aromas of violet, red fruits, strawberry and black cherry. Baking spices, chocolate, notes of dried cranberry, hibiscus tea and tarragon shine through on the palate.		
Vinsobres Les Cornuds; Famille Perrin (Rhône Valley, France)	11	39
Rich and complex with notes of brandy cherries, blackberries, black fruit jam and chocolate. Full and powerful on the palate with gourmet aromas, round tannins and perfectly balanced acidity.		
Domaine de Valmoissine; Louis Latour (Coteaux du Verdon, France)		37
Elegant and fruity with remarkable finesse, offering a soft and silky palate with soft tannins.		



ZINFANDEL

	Glass / Bottle
Old Ghost; Klinker Brick (Lodi, California) Deep blackberry and plum aromas mingle with the vanilla and toast of the barrels to deliver soft, supple tannins and strong complexity.	90
Rombauer (St. Helena, California) Bright fruit aromas of cherry and red plum with notes of vanilla, holiday spices, and lavender. Plum flavors continue to the palate, joined by layers of raspberry jam, mocha, clove, and white pepper. The mid-palate is soft and creamy, framed by fine tannins and ending with a long, lush finish.	20 76
Dry Creek (Sonoma County, California) Complex with bright acidity, complemented by deeper notes of dark berries, mocha, white pepper and wild sage brush.	12 50
Predator (Lodi, California) Intense and full-bodied wine with red fruit, blackberry and spice. Big and bold with hallmark "old vine" velvety texture, spice and vibrant varietal flavors. Lingering tannins over a long, smoky finish.	11 37

UNIQUE REDS

Opus One (Napa Valley, California) Aromas of blackberry, crème de cassis, black cherry, white pepper and rose petals. Flavors of fresh and juicy black fruit, accented with hints of orange zest, licorice and dark chocolate. Round tannins and acidity combine to create a soft, creamy mouthfeel and extend the flavors into a long, persistent finish.	473
8 Years in the Desert; Orin Swift (Napa Valley, California) Predominate zinfandel blended with sirah. Complex flavors of ripe, brambly fruit, earthy notes and hints of espresso.	135
Paraduxx; Duckhorn Vineyards (Napa Valley, California) Dark and brambly with raspberry, black cherry, cedar and dark chocolate notes plus hints of pepper, cinnamon, clove and molasses.	105
Caymus-Suisun Grand Durif (Suisun Valley, California) Notes of blackberries, rose petals and hint of clove. Flavors of berry cobbler mingle with leather, a wisp of campfire, blooming flowers and chocolate-covered raisins. Dark chocolate and bright fruit come through on the finish.	15 55
The Walking Fool Red Blend; Caymus-Suisun (Suisun Valley, California) Medium-bodied with ripe red berry, blackberry and spiced flavors. A wonderful texture on the back end that lingers and is extraordinarily savory through the finish.	13 48
Pessimist; DAOU Vineyards (Paso Robles, California) Aromas of blueberry, boysenberry, black plum, truffle, cocoa and cardamom spice. On the palate, black cherry, blueberry, crème de cassis and hints of lavender, anise and black olive complement the rich, ripe fruit flavors.	12 41
