



## Cabernet Sauvignon

**Caymus Special Selection (Napa Valley, California) 360**

From the best barrels Caymus sets aside each year of its award-winning cabernet sauvignon. Distinguished by extremely fine, velvety tannins, a wine of structure with intense concentration of supple flavors and dark fruits. Touch of vanilla, chocolate, oak, plum and crème de cassis.

**Silver Oak (Napa Valley, California) 252**

Tight, tannic and full-bodied with cedar, dried currant, sage and herbal notes.

**Artemis; Stag's Leap (Napa Valley, California) 156**

Inviting aromas of black cherry and plum with hints of vanilla.

**Caymus (Fairfield, California) 155**

Layered, lush aromas and flavors including cocoa, crème de cassis and ripe berries. Touch of earthiness, smoke, leather, blackberries, plum and vanilla.

**Raymond Reserve Velvet (Napa Valley, California) 105**

A sweet kiss of crème de cassis, licorice, camphor and subtle toast, with silky tannin and impressive purity and length.

**St. Francis (Sonoma County, California) 53**

Deep aromas of dark plum, oak, tobacco and spice.

## Merlot

**Decoy Limited; Duckhorn (Alexander Valley, California) 57**

Fragrances of ripe raspberry, Bing cherry and red currant, as well as notions of cedar and sweet baking spice from oak aging. On the palate, velvety tannins, red berry and spice flow to a long, juicy finish.

## Pinot Noir

**Benton-Lane (Willamette Valley, Oregon) 65**

Vibrant notes of bright red fruits like cherries and cranberries mingle with subtle notes of baking spice.

**Clark and Telephone; Belle Glos (Santa Barbara, California) 58**

Lush aromas of ripe cherry, nutmeg, dark chocolate and holiday baking spices. Bold and complex flavors of black plum, crushed raspberry and blueberry pie linger on the palate.

## Malbec

**Red Schooner by Caymus Voyage 10 (Napa Valley, California) 58**

Made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains of Argentina and shipped chilled to Napa Valley, then produced in Caymus style: dense, dark, powerful and supple. Strikingly smooth, with scents and flavors of dark fruit and fine, textural tannins.

## *Chardonnay*

### **Cake Bread (Napa Valley, California)**

**97**

Light, golden color with aromas of green apple, lemon and pear accented by hints of white flowers and baking spice. Palate is medium-bodied with flavors of ripe melon, lemon curd, crème brûlée and vanilla. Fresh acidity and just-picked citrus flavors are balanced with subtle oak notes.

### **Sonoma-Cutrer (Sonoma County, California)**

**63**

Intense, showing spicy citrus flavors that are tight and full-bodied, ending with a flinty, mineral aftertaste.

## *Sauvignon Blanc*

### **Whitehaven (Marlborough, New Zealand)**

**48**

Displays lift of grapefruit and white currants with hints of freshly crushed herbs.

## *Pinot Grigio*

### **Chloe (Valdadige, Italy)**

**42**

Flavors of juicy white peach, soft melon, crisp apple and floral honeysuckle with a subtle undertone of Meyer lemon.

## *Moscato*

### **Cherry Blossom Moscato; Oliver Winery (Bloomington, Indiana)**

**37**

Luxurious sweetness and tropical character balanced by the bright, fresh tartness of Montmorency cherries.
